



22nd CALL PROJECTS

« International PhD study and training opportunities in Nord-Pas-de-Calais »

To all PhD students in Nord-Pas de Calais

The 22nd call for projects is part of the **Department of International Action (DAI) from the doctoral college Lille Nord de France**. The objectives are as follows:

- to promote international cooperation amongst the six PhD schools,
- to organise new and coordinated research projects to support PhD student training, and to promote international mobility,
- to make PhD schools internationally attractive

This call for projects directly finances the doctoral student's host laboratory, which covers the basic mission expenses. Each project must be co-funded by the laboratory or any other institutional partner. Only co-financing concerning the PhD student's mission and stays are eligible. Operating or equipment funding for the scientific project are not included in the funding base.

The DAI can contribute only up to **€3,000**, and cannot exceed **50% of the total budget**. The presence of sufficient co-funding will be a crucial factor in the application assessment.

The research mobility must last a **minimum of one month**.

Warning : the DAI's scholarship does not include mobilities within the framework of a joint supervised thesis.

THE DAI SCHOLARSHIP WILL ONLY BE AWARDED ONCE PER DOCTORAL STUDENT DURING HIS OR HER THESIS.

ACTION TYPE

- A. OUTGOING MOBILITY** within the framework of the research activity of PhD students registered in a regional institution towards the International. **To enable students** conducting research under the auspices of a regional establishment to move abroad. This action **does not** include travel to conferences/congresses/summer schools.
- B. ORGANISATION OF INTERNATIONAL PhD STUDENTS MEETINGS**
- C. INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS** to support international projects implemented by regional PhD student associations (or groups) submitted with their PhD school endorsement.

Practical information regarding the call for projects n°22:

The project developer must be a PhD student or a student association registered in Nord-Pas-de-Calais sub-region.

- The DAI call concerns projects taking place during the 2nd half of 2019. It is published on the **5th of April 2019, and will be closed on the 16th of May 2019 at 5pm.**
- The Doctoral College will examine and select projects. The selection committee is composed of members of the Doctoral College.
- The DAI will notify the nominees the 29th of Mai 2019 on the following website: <http://www.cue-lillenorddefrance.fr/?q=college-doctoral-aide-la-mobilite>
- A brief scientific assessment (1 to 2 pages) must be provided to the DAI within 2 weeks after the end of the mobility.
- A financial report must be provided by the beneficiary to his laboratory within 2 weeks after the end of the mobility.

Applications must be completed online. Please complete and sign the application form (4 pages maximum) and return as a PDF file attachment via the website.

Applications must contain the following information:

- The type of project (**A, B, C**)
- The contact information of the project developer
- Reasoned opinions and signatures from the thesis director, laboratory director, and the approval of the PhD school director.
- The project's name and a brief description
- The projected budget, including co-funding
- **QUOTATIONS FOR TRANSPORT AND ACCOMMODATION**
- The (justified) request for the solicited amount (not to exceed €3,000)
